

About the NHS Test and Trace app

The app is free to use, and you will not be charged for downloading or using it.

- DO download the NHS Test and Trace app to your smartphone so it's with you as you move around.
- DO NOT use your laptop or iPad.
- Bluetooth must be enabled at all times for the app to work. To switch this on, go to your phone's settings.
- The NHS Test and Trace app is not yet available to install through the Huawei AppGallery.
- For Apple phones, you will need versions 13.5 or higher.
 Android phones will need Marshmallow or version 6.0 or higher.

Your identity will be protected, along with the identity of those you have been near to. This app does not use GPS or record locations so you cannot be tracked. More information can be found at: www.covid19.nhs.uk

How to download the NHS Test and Trace app to both Apple and Android devices

- 1. Unlock your phone. Scroll through your phone to find an app called "App Store" or "Google Play Store". Tap on it to launch it.
- Tap on the search bar. Type in "NHS COVID-19".
 You can now see a list of results below the box.
 Tap on a result with the name "NHS COVID-19 app".
- 3. There will be a list of results of different Covid-19 apps. Find one with the **NHS COVID-19** logo, tap to download it.
- 4. Once the app is downloaded, open it and follow the instructions within the app.
- 5. You will be asked to enter a unique 8 digit code. Please use 1 of the 4 codes provided in the letter sent to your household with the leaflet.

If you are having difficulty installing the app on your phone or need help to find the code on your letter please ask a friend, family member, neighbour or carer for assistance.
